RE: Response to COVID-19 Concerns

Dear BISD students, families, and friends,

Due to information provided from local medical professionals, and although at this time there are no confirmed cases, Breckenridge ISD is now reacting to the corona virus as if it is present in our community. Therefore, students will remain on an extended spring break through Friday, March 20. All staff will report to their campus or supervisor between the hours of 8:00 A. M. and 3:30 P. M. beginning Tuesday, March 17 and for the remainder of this week.

District leadership is in communication with state and local health authorities and officials to aid in making these decisions. We will keep lines of communication open in an effort to make the best decisions for the health and safety of our community and students. We will continue to be as transparent and communicative as allowable. Please understand that the information we are receiving is very fluid and adjustments will be made as required.

All communication regarding the COVID-19 emergency will be posted to the Breckenridge ISD website. We know you may have questions and we will respond as quickly as possible; however, please recognize that we are working to mitigate the impact of the virus and provide instruction and meals to students. Please allow for a reasonable response time to your questions.

Breakfast and lunch will be served to all students beginning Tuesday, March 17, 2020. Each campus cafeteria will be providing meals on a pick-up basis. Please check the COVID-19 section of the District website for times and pick-up locations.
