To whom it may concern:

Please be advised, as of today, the Texas Department of Agriculture is requiring school districts to ask that parents/guardians have their children in the vehicle with them when they pull up to receive their meals.

BISD is in communication with the Texas Department of Agriculture and other government agencies requesting leniency on this matter, should their rules change we will gladly comply.

BISD is looking for other avenues to help feed the children in our community, which in the future may include limited delivery to a specific site or sites. Please watch the BISD website for updates.

We realize that this may not be the most convenient way to handle the current situation, however, we ask your cooperation moving forward.

Here are some important facts to remember:

BISD is only serving meals to go, so you or your child(ren) may go to any of the District's campuses to receive a meal, you/they do not have to go to the campus they are enrolled in. For details on where each campus' pick up location is, refer to the BISD website.

Children do not have to have their parents with them to receive a meal, they may walk to the closest campus during feeding times and receive a meal.

As well, if you have multiple children at multiple campuses, you may take them all to the campus most convenient to you to receive all meals.

The District is serving breakfast and lunch, Monday through Friday.
