**Welcome:** Chairperson, Shai Berry, called the meeting to order and welcomed guest.

**Review of Sex Education Curriculum:** Kathey Collinsworth who had presented the “Worth the Wait” program gave a short overview of the program to the committee. The “Wait Training” curriculum overview was brought by Alicia Berry, South Elementary nurse who is a qualified trainer for the program.

The committee had questions for each of the program representatives followed by a discussion of each program. The discussion was centered on identifying the strengths and weakness of both curriculums. Worth the Wait is more clinical in its approach to sex education while Wait Training focused on relationships and the importance of sex within the realms of marriage.
